



Kelowna firm lands contract for '06 Olympics

Beyond Audio of **Kelowna** has landed a **\$ 250,000 contract** to design and install all the electronics and electrics at the B.C. Canada House being built for the **2006 Winter Olympics in Turin, Italy**.

"It's very exciting because it's connected to the Olympics and it will give us worldwide exposure," says Beyond Audio resident **Mike Ohman**.

"But it's actually a pretty nuts and bolts project because it's what we do every day."

Beyond Audio will make at least two trips to Italy for installation and may be hured to be on site during the Olympics to make sure everything runs smoothly.

B.C. Canada House is being built by **Sitka Log Homes of 100 Mile House**, and it will be used to showcase the province's business, tourism and culture to the worldwide audience that will take in the Games.

Beyond Audio will do a myriad of jobs including the **extensive computer network, multi-lingual multi-media systems for three boardrooms, the lighting control system, background music and paging systems, and interfacing with the security and fire alarm systems**.
